- On 09-29-2011 at 2:13 A.M., Cameron Witter, age 22 of Fayetteville, Arkansas and Joshua Witter, age 25 of Douglas, Wyoming, were traveling north on Crossover on their motorcycles just south of Hyland Park. Due to excessive speed and following each other too closely, they both went off the roadway in the same spot while negotiating a curve. One of them impacted a telephone pole and crushed a R.I.P cross that was already there. The other barely missed the pole and tumbled on the ground. Both were transported to WRMC. A severely broken femur, broken facial bones, and some bruises are the injuries known at this point. Alcohol may be a factor in this incident so blood was drawn at WRMC.

- No arrests were made on Wednesday night.
- There are no projected street closures for Thursday.
